"It will always be Pentecost in the Church," affirmed Blessed Oscar Romero, Archbishop of El Salvador, on Pentecost Sunday 1978, "provided the

Church lets the beauty of the Holy Spirit shine forth from her countenance. When the Church ceases to let her strength rest on the Power from above which Christ promised her and which he gave her on that day, and when the Church leans rather on the weak forces of the power or wealth of this earth, then the Church ceases to be newsworthy. The Church will be fair to see, perennially young, attractive in every age, as long as she is faithful to the Spirit that floods her and she reflects that Spirit through her communities, through her pastors, through her very life"

The Violence of Love, The Plough Pub. Co., [Archbishop Oscar Romero was beatified May 23, 2015 by Pope Francis.]

Archbishop Romero's declaration reminds us -- as does today's Gospel -- that Pentecost is not just one day, but *every* day. Without breath, there is no life. Without the Spirit, the Church is a field of dry, dead bones. The Venerable Fulton J. Sheen once said about the Church, "Even though we are God's *chosen people*, we often behave more like God's *frozen people* --frozen in our prayer life, frozen in the way we relate with one another, frozen in the way we celebrate our Faith." [Bishop Fulton J. Sheen was declared Venerable by Pope Benedict XVI in June, 2012.] Today is a great day to ask the Holy Spirit to rekindle in us the spirit of new life and enthusiasm, the fire of God's love. Let us repeat Blessed John Henry Cardinal Newman's favorite little prayer, "*Come Holy Spirit*."

*"Come Holy Spirit
Make our ears to hear
Make our eyes to see
Make our mouths to speak
Make our hearts to seek
Make our hands to reach out
And touch the world with your love. AMEN."*

"Siempre será Pentecostés en la Iglesia", afirmó San Óscar Romero, Arzobispo de El Salvador, el domingo de Pentecostés de 1978, "siempre que la Iglesia deje resplandecer en su rostro la belleza del Espíritu Santo. Cuando la Iglesia deje de reposar su fuerza en el Poder de lo alto que Cristo le prometió y que le dio en aquel día, y cuando la Iglesia se apoye más bien en las débiles fuerzas del poder o riqueza de esta tierra, entonces la Iglesia dejará de ser noticia. La Iglesia será bella de ver, perennemente joven, atractiva en todos los tiempos, siempre que sea fiel al Espíritu que la inunda y refleje ese Espíritu a través de sus comunidades, a través de sus pastores, a través de su misma vida"

La declaración de Monseñor Romero nos recuerda, al igual que el Evangelio de hoy, que Pentecostés no es solo un día, sino todos los días. Sin aliento, no hay vida. Sin el Espíritu, la Iglesia es un campo de huesos secos y muertos. El Venerable Fulton J. Sheen dijo una vez sobre la Iglesia: "Aunque somos el pueblo elegido de Dios, a menudo nos comportamos más como el pueblo congelado de Dios: congelados en nuestra vida de oración, congelados en la forma en que nos relacionamos unos con otros, congelados en la forma en que celebramos nuestra Fe".


