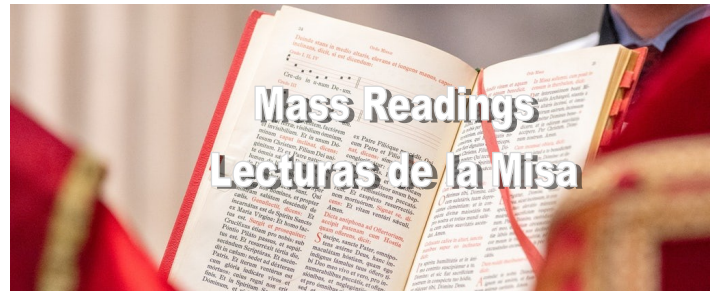

**First Reading** – Isaiah 6:1-2A, 3-8: Isaiah saw the Lord on His throne, felt unworthy, but was cleansed by a seraphim. When God asked for a messenger, Isaiah offered to go.

**Responsorial Psalm** – Psalm 138: I will thank and praise God for His kindness and truth. He answers me and gives me strength. All will praise Him for His great glory and enduring kindness.

**Second Reading** – 1 Corinthians 15:1-11: Christ died for our sins, was buried, and rose on the third day. He appeared to many, including me. By God's grace, I preach, and you believed.

**Gospel** – Luke 5:1-11: Jesus told Simon to fish in deep water. They caught so many fish that their nets almost broke. Simon, James, and John were amazed. Jesus said they would now catch people. They left everything to follow him.

**Primera lectura** – Isaías 6:1-2A, 3-8: Isaías vio al Señor en su trono, se sintió indigno, pero fue purificado por un serafín. Cuando Dios pidió un mensajero, Isaías se ofreció a ir.

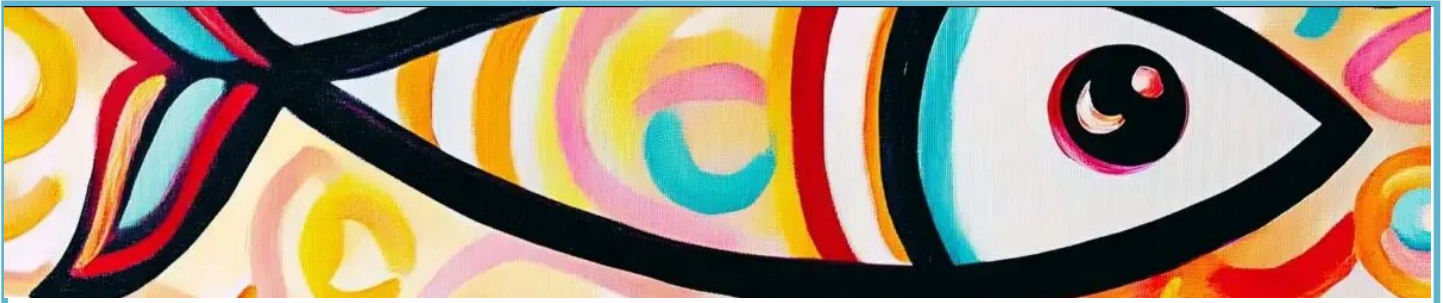

## Siguiendo a Jesús

En el Evangelio, Jesús llama a Pedro, Santiago y Juan a seguirlo. Él llama a personas comunes y corrientes a ser sus discípulos, mostrando que cualquiera que esté dispuesto a seguirlo puede ser utilizado para sus propósitos.

La respuesta de los pescadores es inmediata. Dejan todo y siguen a Jesús. Este acto de dejar atrás su sustento y seguridad demuestra su confianza y compromiso. Nos enseña que seguir a Jesús a menudo requiere sacrificio y voluntad de dejar de lado nuestros propios planes.

La elección de Jesús de estos improbables seguidores resalta que Él valora un corazón dispuesto por encima de las calificaciones. No busca a los más educados ni a los más capacitados, sino a aquellos dispuestos a entregarse plenamente a Él. Esto nos da esperanza a todos, ya que muestra que no necesitamos ser perfectos para ser usados por Dios.

Nuestro llamado a seguir a Jesús es similar. Puede que nos sintamos no calificados o indignos, pero Jesús nos invita a confiar en Él y seguirlo de todo corazón. Al responder a este llamado, nos embarcamos en un camino de fe, confiando en que Jesús nos guiará y equipará.

Como los pescadores, estamos llamados a dejar atrás todo lo que obstaculiza nuestro compromiso y seguir a Jesús con todo el corazón.

El Quinto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario Año C nos anima a reflexionar sobre la santidad de Dios, nuestra indignidad, el poder de la gracia de Dios y el llamado a seguir a Jesús. Estas reflexiones nos recuerdan que, a pesar de nuestras deficiencias, estamos llamados a dar testimonio de nuestra fe y servir a Dios de todo corazón. Que estos temas nos inspiren a crecer en nuestra fe y confianza en la guía de Dios.

## Following Jesus

In the Gospel, Jesus calls Peter, James, and John to follow him. He calls ordinary people to be his disciples, showing that anyone willing to follow him can be used for his purposes.

The fishermen's response is immediate. They leave everything behind and follow Jesus. This act of leaving their livelihood and security behind demonstrates their trust and commitment. It teaches us that following Jesus often requires sacrifice and a willingness to let go of our own plans.

Jesus' choice of these unlikely followers highlights that he values a willing heart above qualifications. He doesn't look for the most educated or the most capable, but those willing to give themselves fully to him. This gives hope to all of us, as it shows that we don't need to be perfect to be used by God.

Our call to follow Jesus is similar. We may feel unqualified or unworthy, but Jesus invites us to trust in him and follow him wholeheartedly. As we respond to this call, we embark on a journey of faith, trusting that Jesus will lead and equip us. Like the fishermen, we are called to leave behind everything that hinders our commitment and follow Jesus with all our hearts.

The Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C encourages us to reflect on the holiness of God, our unworthiness, the power of God's grace, and the call to follow Jesus. These reflections remind us that, despite our shortcomings, we are called to bear witness to our faith and serve God wholeheartedly. May these themes inspire us to grow in our faith and trust in God's guidance.
