## SUNDAY MASS READINGS

First Reading – Wisdom 9:13-18B: Understanding God's intentions is beyond human capacity without divine wisdom and the Holy Spirit, as earthly concerns often cloud our judgment.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 90: God, timeless and eternal, teaches us to value our days and seeks our return to righteousness, offering mercy and favor throughout our fleeting lives.

Second Reading – Philemon 9-10, 12-17: Paul, imprisoned, sends Onesimus back to Philemon, not as a slave but as a beloved brother, urging Philemon to welcome him as he would Paul himself.

Gospel – Luke 14:25-33: Jesus teaches that following him requires prioritizing him above all personal relationships and possessions, emphasizing the need to consider the sacrifices involved, much like planning a construction or a battle.

## LECTURAS DOMINICALES

Primera Lectura – Sabiduría 9,13-18B: Comprender las intenciones de Dios supera la capacidad humana sin la sabiduría divina y el Espíritu Santo, ya que las preocupaciones terrenales a menudo nublan nuestro juicio.

Salmo Responsorial – Salmo 90: Dios, eterno y atemporal, nos enseña a valorar nuestros días y busca nuestro retorno a la justicia, ofreciendo misericordia y favor a lo largo de nuestras fugaces vidas.

Segunda Lectura – Filemón 9-10, 12-17: Pablo, encarcelado, envía a Onésimo de vuelta a Filemón, no como esclavo, sino como hermano amado, instando a Filemón a acogerlo como lo haría con el mismo Pablo.

Evangelio – Lucas 14,25-33: Jesús enseña que seguirlo requiere priorizarlo por encima de todas las relaciones y posesiones personales, enfatizando la necesidad de considerar los sacrificios que implica, como planificar una construcción o una batalla.





### Acogiendo a los Demás como Familia

En la segunda lectura para el 23° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario del Año C, Pablo le pide a Filemón que reciba a Onésimo como a un hermano en Cristo. Onésimo fue una vez un sirviente, pero Pablo anima a Filemón a verlo de manera diferente ahora. Este es un recordatorio de que la fe cambia la forma en que vemos y tratamos a los demás.

Cuando seguimos a Cristo, somos parte de una sola familia. Esto significa que, sin importar el trasfondo, la raza o el estatus de alguien, es nuestro hermano o hermana. Acoger a los demás en nuestras vidas con amabilidad y amor refleja la manera en que Dios nos acoge.

Esta lectura nos desafía a reflexionar sobre cómo tratamos a las personas que nos rodean. ¿Hay personas que evitamos o juzgamos porque parecen diferentes? Cristo nos llama a ir más allá de esas barreras y ver a cada persona como un hijo de Dios. Este tipo de amor puede sanar divisiones y crear comunidades más fuertes.

### Welcoming Others as Family

In the second reading for the 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C, Paul asks Philemon to welcome Onesimus as a brother in Christ. Onesimus was once a servant, but Paul encourages Philemon to see him differently now. This is a reminder that faith changes how we see and treat others.

When we follow Christ, we are part of one family. This means that no matter someone's background, race, or status, they are our brother or sister. Welcoming others into our lives with kindness and love reflects the way God welcomes us.

This reading challenges us to think about how we treat the people around us. Are there people we avoid or judge because they seem different? Christ calls us to go beyond those barriers and to see each person as a child of God. This kind of love can heal divisions and create stronger communities.

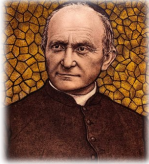
