Respondiendo al llamado a formar discípulos

El Evangelio de la Ascensión del Señor (Ciclo A) recuerda a los creyentes que Jesús está siempre con ellos. Aunque asciende al cielo, no abandona a sus seguidores; les encomienda la misión de hacer discípulos y difundir sus enseñanzas.

Formerly known as RCIA, is the process through which non-baptized adults (18 yrs old +), baptized Christians from other denominations, and baptized Catholics seeking completion enter the Roman Catholic Church. It involves a journey of study, prayer, and liturgical rites.
