

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is for non-Baptized adults or adults who were baptized in other Christian denominations who are considering becoming full members of the Roman Catholic Church.

The RCIA program prepares these adults to become full members of the Church for Confirmation and Communion in the Roman Catholic Church.

The program also welcomes adults who were baptized into the Catholic Church as infants but who never received further catechesis, and did not receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and Communion.

Policies and Enrollment

RCIA preparation is a 6-month program.

It includes education in Catholic doctrine and morality, Bible study, participation in the parish community, and self-reflection.

The group meets from September through May.
