LECTURAS DOMINICALES

Primera Lectura – Eclesiástico 3:17-18, 20, 28-29: Sé humilde en todo lo que hagas y serás amado. Busca la sabiduría, evita lo que te supera y da limosna para expiar los pecados.

Salmo Responsorial – Salmo 68: Dios provee a los pobres y necesitados, dándoles un hogar y alegrando a los justos. Protege a los huérfanos y a las viudas, y revitaliza la tierra para su pueblo.

Segunda Lectura – Hebreos 12:18-19, 22-24A: Has llegado a la Jerusalén celestial, donde se reúnen los ángeles y los justos, y Jesús media una nueva alianza con su sangre poderosa y redentora.

Evangelio – Lucas 14:1, 7-14: Jesús enseñó sobre la humildad, aconsejando a los invitados a ocupar el último lugar y a los anfitriones a invitar a quienes no pueden corresponder. Prometió que quienes se humillen serán exaltados y recompensados en la resurrección.

SUNDAY MASS READINGS

First Reading – Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29: Be humble in all you do, and you will be loved. Seek wisdom, avoid what is beyond you, and give alms to atone for sins.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 68: God provides for the poor and needy, giving them a home and bringing joy to the righteous. He protects orphans and widows, and revives the land for his people.

Second Reading – Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24A: You have come to the heavenly Jerusalem, where angels and the righteous gather, and Jesus mediates a new covenant with his powerful, redemptive blood.

Gospel – Luke 14:1, 7-14: Jesus taught about humility, advising guests to take the lowest place and hosts to invite those who cannot repay. He promised that those who humble themselves will be exalted and will be rewarded at the resurrection.

Inclusive Banquet of Jesus

In Jesus' day, a banquet was a way to show off wealth. Having a bounty of food for the guests showed that you were a person of means. They also displayed one's social standing, especially since they were too large to hold indoors. Everyone could see who was in attendance. Important guests indicated that the host was also important. And these guests were given a good seat, so they could see and be seen.

In turn, it was expected that these important guests would return the favor and invite the hosts to their homes. In doing so, both host and guest would be honored again. And so the cycle continued.

The poor and disadvantaged had no place in this way of doing things. They would not bring status to the host who invited them. And they certainly couldn't repay the favor. So those who had little were left on the outside of the banquet, looking in.

Jesus invites all of us to his banquet. In fact, he always seems to go out of his way to bring in those who are on the fringes of society. We are all important guests. In the same way, we must follow his example and reach out to those who seem to be left out or pushed aside, whether in our families, our communities, or our churches.

The readings for the 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C teach us valuable lessons. Humility, generosity, and respect for all are key themes. By reflecting on these readings, we can grow in our faith and live more like Christ.

Banquete Inclusivo de Jesús

En la época de Jesús, un banquete era una forma de presumir de riqueza. Ofrecer abundante comida a los invitados demostraba que se era una persona adinerada. También demostraba la posición social, especialmente porque eran demasiado grandes para celebrarse en un espacio cerrado. Todos podían ver quiénes asistían. Los invitados importantes indicaban que el anfitrión también lo era. Y a estos invitados se les daba un buen asiento para que pudieran ver y ser vistos.

A su vez, se esperaba que estos invitados importantes devolvieran el favor e invitaran a los anfitriones a sus casas. Al hacerlo, tanto el anfitrión como el invitado eran honrados de nuevo. Y así continuaba el ciclo.

Los pobres y desfavorecidos no tenían cabida en esta forma de proceder. No aportaban estatus al anfitrión que los invitaba. Y ciertamente no podían corresponder al favor. Así que los que tenían poco se quedaban fuera del banquete, mirando hacia dentro.

Jesús nos invita a todos a su banquete. De hecho, siempre parece hacer todo lo posible para incluir a los marginados de la sociedad. Todos somos invitados importantes. De la misma manera, debemos seguir su ejemplo y acercarnos a quienes parecen estar excluidos o marginados, ya sea en nuestras familias, comunidades o iglesias.

Las lecturas del 22.º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, Año C, nos enseñan valiosas lecciones. La humildad, la generosidad y el respeto por todos son temas clave. Al reflexionar sobre estas lecturas, podemos crecer en nuestra fe y vivir más como Cristo.
