In the gospels there are plenty of times when Jesus is with people eating and drinking. As always, Jesus is concerned with people and their real needs. They are hungry, so he feeds them. He is gracious in his abundant giving. But he feeds them not only with food; he also feeds them at a much deeper level. He teaches them, he welcomes them and he heals them. He treats us the same way; when we gather to celebrate the Eucharist, Jesus welcomes us, he speaks to us and through his Body and Blood, we are nourished and we are healed.

The Eucharist is God's greatest gifts to us. But it is not our right and we cannot demand it. Pope Francis reminds us of this when he says, 'the Eucharist is not a prize for the perfect, but a powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak.' That's all of us and each of us!

St. Augustine, the great church writer said, 'become what you receive.' If we celebrate the Eucharist with each other and receive the Body and Blood of Christ, then we are called to be the Body of Christ, the Church today. And we are asked to be a missionary church. At the end every celebration of the Eucharist we are sent out with this great prayer of mission, let us go now to love and serve the Lord. If we share in the gift of Jesus' Body and Blood, then we are also asked to share this with others when leave church. Today on this wonderful feast, may each of us be fed, nourished and healed through the Body and Blood of Christ.

En los evangelios hay muchos momentos en los que Jesús está con la gente comiendo y bebiendo. Como siempre, Jesús se preocupa por las personas y sus necesidades reales. Si celebramos la Eucaristía entre nosotros y recibimos el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, entonces estamos llamados a ser el Cuerpo de Cristo, la Iglesia de hoy. Y se nos pide que seamos una iglesia misionera. Al final de cada celebración de la Eucaristía somos enviados con esta gran oración de misión, vayamos ahora a amar y servir al Señor. Si compartimos el don del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús, también se nos pide que compartamos esto con otros cuando salgamos de la iglesia. Hoy, en esta maravillosa fiesta, que cada uno de nosotros sea alimentado, nutrido y sanado a través del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo.
