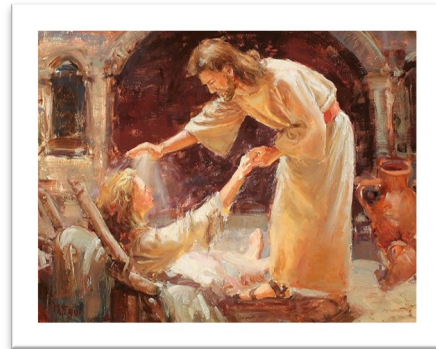

The 6th Sunday of Easter Year A reminds us that sharing our faith is not something we do by ourselves. In the first reading, Philip preaches in Samaria, and many people believe. Later, Peter and John come to pray for them, and they receive the Holy Spirit. This shows that the Holy Spirit is active in spreading the faith.

Jesus tells His disciples that the Holy Spirit will teach them and remind them of everything He has said. This is important for all who share the Gospel. We do not have to rely only on our own knowledge or strength. The Holy Spirit helps us speak and act in a way that brings others closer to God.

The early Christians trusted in the Holy Spirit, and amazing things happened. People heard the message of Jesus, believed, and were baptized. The Holy Spirit worked through the apostles and gave them courage. Even in difficult times, they continued to share the Good News. The 6th Sunday of Easter Year A reminds us that we, too, are called to share our faith. We do not have to be afraid, because the Holy Spirit is with us. When we trust in God’s guidance, we can help others know His love.
