Please Note: For Baptisms or Weddings, you must be a practicing Catholic and a member of the parish.

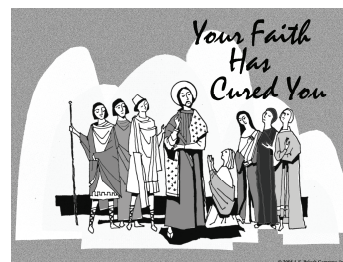

JESUS' EXAMPLE OF HELPING OTHERS

In today's second reading Paul offers a wonderful argument to his converts at Corinth for seeking to help those in need. He is dealing with a practical problem, arranging a collection for the poor of the church of Jerusalem; but as he often does, he develops an important teaching about Jesus to make his point.

After asking that they show their faith by generous gifts, he reminds them of the "gracious act of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, for your sake he became poor, so that by his poverty you might become rich" (2 Corinthians 8:9). In the Incarnation our Lord assumed our human nature, certainly becoming poor for one who is God. The ultimate gracious act of this poverty was going to the cross with all its terrible sufferings. By this act of poverty we definitely become rich. Now our sins can be forgiven; we can share in the very life of God through the sacraments; we can attain eternal salvation!

Dear Parishioners of St. Kevin's Church,

I am writing this letter to You today, as my time in St. Kevin's Parish comes to an end. I would like to express my gratitude and thank you all for the last five years during which I was honored to be your pastor. I am grateful to all the members of my Pastoral Council, Finance Committee and so many of you who are being involved in many different ministries.

I am grateful to everyone of you who helped me over the years to improve our church facilities which includes a new LED lighting system in the Sanctuary, that allow us to change the colors according to the Liturgical Calendar, refurbishing the cross over the main altar, refreshing our Confessional Room and establishing the Parish Archives that has been open and blessed during the Feast of St. Kevin in 2017, in anticipation of the upcoming 100th Anniversary of our Parish and St. Kevin's church in 2022.

Another additions to our church are the images of Our Lady of Czestochowa (Black Madonna), Divine Mercy and the portrait of St. Pope John Paul II. New Processional Cross, sets of new vestments and church banners have been donated to our church.

Many sacramental and religious services occurred in the past five years: Baptisms (52), First Communion (48), Confirmations (23), Marriages (7), Funerals (65).

Many special events have taken place: Feast of St. Kevin during which we honored many Parishioners for their active participation in the life of the Parish; A beautiful sign of giving thanks was our Thanksgiving Brunch. Dinner Dance and Auction our Fundraiser Evening, rededication of the O'Malley Hall and 50th Anniversary of Marie Annuzzi.

In March 2019, 30 parishioners participated in the spiritual journey - pilgrimage to the Holy Land following the footsteps of Jesus. It was very spiritually enriching and community building experience that will be cherished for many years to come.

Unfortunately, last year because of the global pandemic our church activities and participation was very limited but I am grateful to all of you who still were able to support our church and show a spirit of responsibility, which is a sign of being a Good Steward of the gifts and talents you have been given. Thank you all for your trust, support and generosity.

Life is always changing and everything, whether good or bad, will eventually come to an end. Nothing in this life remains the same; only God is unchanging and constant in His love, at all times. God loves all of us and that will never change.

While I am leaving you, there is one who remains constant: Jesus Christ. Jesus has been here from the beginning, and will be with you for the rest of time.
