U.S. Cardinal Robert Prevost has been elected pope, the first time an American has led the Roman Catholic Church. Prevost, chose the name Pope Leo XIV.

Who is the new pope?

Robert Francis Prevost, 69, was born in Chicago.

Despite his American roots, his life has transcended borders. He served for two decades in Peru, where he became a bishop and a naturalized citizen, then rose to lead his international religious order.

Leading up to the death of his predecessor, Cardinal Prevost held one of the most influential Vatican posts, running the office that selects and manages bishops globally.

A member of the Order of St. Augustine, he resembles Francis in his commitment to the poor and migrants, and to meeting people where they are. He told the Vatican's official news website last year that "the bishop is not supposed to be a little prince sitting in his kingdom." He has spent much of his life outside the United States. Ordained in 1982 at 27, he received a doctorate in canon law at the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome. In Peru, he was a missionary, parish priest, teacher and bishop.

¿Quién es el nuevo papa?

Robert Francis Prevost, de 69 años, nació en Chicago.

A pesar de sus raíces estadounidenses, su vida ha trascendido fronteras. Sirvió durante dos décadas en Perú, donde se convirtió en obispo y se nacionalizó, y luego ascendió a la jefatura de su orden religiosa internacional.

Antes del fallecimiento de su predecesor, el cardenal Prevost ocupó uno de los cargos más influyentes del Vaticano, dirigiendo la oficina que selecciona y gestiona a los obispos a nivel mundial.

Miembro de la Orden de San Agustín, se asemeja a Francisco en su compromiso con los pobres y los migrantes, y en su compromiso de atender a las personas donde se encuentren. El año pasado, declaró al sitio web oficial de noticias del Vaticano que «el obispo no debe ser un pequeño príncipe sentado en su reino». Ha pasado gran parte de su vida fuera de Estados Unidos. Ordenado en 1982 a los 27 años, se doctoró en derecho canónico en la Universidad Pontificia de Santo Tomás de Aquino en Roma. En Perú, fue misionero, párroco, profesor y obispo.
