LECTURAS DEL DOMINGO

Primera lectura – Hechos 14:21-27: Pablo y Bernabé revisitaron ciudades, animando a sus discípulos y explicándoles las dificultades del reino de Dios. Nombraron líderes de la iglesia, los confiaron al Señor y compartieron el éxito de su misión en Antioquía, enfatizando la ayuda de Dios a los no judíos.

Salmo responsorial – Salmo 145: La compasión y la misericordia del Señor se extienden a todos, lento para la ira y lleno de amor. Sus obras lo alaban, y sus seguidores hablan de su reino eterno y su majestuoso poder.

Segunda lectura – Apocalipsis 21:1-5A: Juan describe un cielo y una tierra nuevos, habiendo desaparecido lo viejo. Ve una espléndida Nueva Jerusalén y escucha a Dios proclamar su morada eterna con la gente, borrando todo dolor y haciendo todo nuevo.

Evangelio – Juan 13:31-33A, 34-35: Jesús habló de su inminente glorificación, entrelazando su honor con el de Dios. Compartió un nuevo mandamiento con sus discípulos: amarse unos a otros como él los amaba. Este amor mutuo entre sus seguidores sería la marca distintiva de su discipulado.

MASS READINGS

First Reading – Acts 14:21-27: Paul and Barnabas revisited cities, encouraging disciples and explaining hardships in God's kingdom. They appointed church leaders, entrusted them to the Lord, and shared their mission success in Antioch, emphasizing God's outreach to non-Jews.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 145: The Lord's compassion and mercy extend to all, slow to anger and full of love. His works praise Him, and His followers speak of His eternal kingdom and majestic power.

Second Reading – Revelation 21:1-5A: John describes a new heaven and earth, with the old gone. He sees a splendid New Jerusalem and hears God proclaim His eternal dwelling with people, erasing all pain and making everything new.

Gospel – John 13:31-33A, 34-35: Jesus spoke of his imminent glorification, intertwining his honor with God's. He shared a new commandment with his disciples: to love one another as he loved them. This mutual love among his followers would be the defining mark of their discipleship

En el quinto domingo de Pascua, Año C, recordamos la importancia de apoyarnos mutuamente en nuestro camino de fe. La Iglesia primitiva, como se ve en los Hechos, nos muestra cómo los creyentes se ayudaban mutuamente. Pablo y Bernabé animaron a los nuevos cristianos a mantenerse firmes en su fe a pesar de los desafíos. Este apoyo fue crucial para construir una comunidad de creyentes fuerte y unida.

El mandato de Jesús de amarnos unos a otros, destacado en el Evangelio, es fundamental para la vida cristiana. Enseñó esta lección en un momento en que sabía que sería traicionado. En lugar de centrarse en sus propios problemas, Jesús enfatizó la importancia de amar a los demás. Esto nos enseña que el amor debe ser la base de nuestras relaciones, incluso en tiempos difíciles.

On the 5th Sunday of Easter Year C, we are reminded of the importance of supporting each other in our faith journeys. The early Church, as seen in Acts, shows us how believers helped one another. Paul and Barnabas encouraged the new Christians to stay strong in their faith despite challenges. This support was crucial in building a strong and united community of believers.

Jesus' command to love one another, highlighted in the Gospel, is central to Christian life. He taught this lesson at a time when He knew He would be betrayed. Instead of focusing on His own troubles, Jesus emphasized the importance of loving others. This teaches us that love should be the foundation of our relationships, even in difficult times.

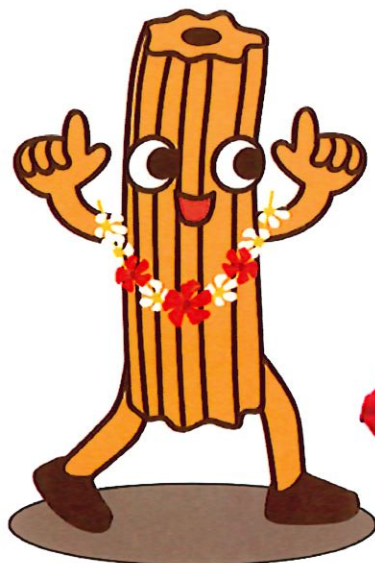
