Am I Willing to Follow?

The readings for Palm Sunday Year A show that following Jesus is not always easy. He does not promise an easy life. He asks people to follow him in humility and service, even when it leads to suffering. Are we willing to follow him in this way?

Jesus showed what true love looks like. He put others before himself. He accepted suffering instead of running from it. He forgave even those who hurt him. This is not the way of the world. The world teaches people to seek power, comfort, and success. Jesus teaches them to serve, sacrifice, and love.

It is easy to admire Jesus from a distance. It is harder to live as he did. Following him means choosing kindness over selfishness, patience over anger, and trust over fear. It means carrying our own crosses, whatever they may be. It means forgiving when it is difficult and loving even those who hurt us.

Palm Sunday Year A asks a simple but difficult question: Are we willing to follow Jesus, no matter the cost? He showed the way, but each person must choose whether to walk it.

The passion story is not just about the past—it challenges people today. It asks them to reflect on their own faith, their willingness to follow Jesus, and their response to suffering. Palm Sunday Year A reminds them that true greatness comes from humility and love. As Holy Week begins, they are invited to walk with Jesus, to stand by him in his suffering, and to follow his example of selfless love.

¿Estoy dispuesto a seguirlo?

Las lecturas del Domingo de Ramos del Ciclo A nos muestran que seguir a Jesús no siempre es fácil. Él no promete una vida cómoda. Pide a las personas que lo sigan con humildad y espíritu de servicio, incluso cuando esto conlleve sufrimiento. ¿Estamos dispuestos a seguirlo de este modo?

Jesús nos mostró cómo es el verdadero amor. Antepuso a los demás a sí mismo. Aceptó el sufrimiento en lugar de huir de él. Perdonó incluso a aquellos que le hicieron daño. Este no es el camino del mundo. El mundo enseña a las personas a buscar el poder, la comodidad y el éxito; Jesús, en cambio, les enseña a servir, a sacrificarse y a amar.

Resulta fácil admirar a Jesús desde la distancia; lo difícil es vivir como él vivió. Seguirlo implica elegir la bondad por encima del egoísmo, la paciencia por encima de la ira y la confianza por encima del miedo. Significa cargar con nuestras propias cruces, sean cuales sean. Significa perdonar cuando resulta difícil y amar incluso a aquellos que nos hieren.

El Domingo de Ramos del Ciclo A nos plantea una pregunta sencilla, pero difícil: ¿Estamos dispuestos a seguir a Jesús, sin importar el precio? Él nos mostró el camino, pero cada persona debe elegir si desea recorrerlo.

El relato de la Pasión no es una cuestión meramente del pasado; interpela a las personas de hoy en día. Las invita a reflexionar sobre su propia fe, sobre su disposición a seguir a Jesús y sobre su actitud ante el sufrimiento. El Domingo de Ramos del Ciclo A nos recuerda que la verdadera grandeza reside en la humildad y el amor. Al dar comienzo la Semana Santa, se nos invita a caminar junto a Jesús, a permanecer a su lado en su sufrimiento y a seguir su ejemplo de amor incondicional.
