Lecturas Dominicales

Primera Lectura – Génesis 14:18-20: Melquisedec, rey de Salem y sacerdote de Dios, trajo pan y vino y bendijo a Abram. Abram le dio a Melquisedec el diezmo de todo.

Salmo Responsorial – Salmo 109: El Señor declara un sacerdocio eterno en el linaje de Melquisedec, promete la victoria sobre los enemigos y asegura la autoridad y el poder divinos.

Segunda Lectura – 1 Corintios 11:23-26: Jesús instituyó la Eucaristía en la Última Cena, diciendo que el pan es su cuerpo y el cáliz es la nueva alianza en su sangre, hecha en memoria suya.

Evangelio – Lucas 9:11-17: Jesús alimentó a una multitud de cinco mil personas con cinco panes y dos peces. Bendijo y partió la comida, distribuyéndola entre sus discípulos. Todos quedaron satisfechos, y se recogieron doce canastas con las sobras.

Mass Readings

First **Reading** – Genesis 14:18-20: Melchizedek, king of Salem and priest of God, brought bread and wine and blessed Abram. Abram gave Melchizedek a tenth of everything.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 110: The LORD declares an eternal priesthood in the line of Melchizedek, promises victory over enemies, and assures divine authority and power.

Second Reading – 1 Corinthians 11:23-26: Jesus instituted the Eucharist at the Last Supper, saying the bread is his body and the cup is the new covenant in his blood, to be done in remembrance of him.

Gospel – Luke 9:11B-17: Jesus fed a crowd of five thousand with five loaves and two fish. He blessed and broke the food, distributing it through his disciples. Everyone was satisfied, and twelve baskets of leftovers were collected.

SAGRADO CORAZON DE JESUS~ SACRED HEART OF JESUS

En el siglo XVII, Jesús reveló a Santa Margarita María Alacoque la devoción a Su Sagrado Corazón para aumentar nuestro amor:

"He aquí el Corazón que ha amado tanto a los hombres que no ha escatimado nada, hasta agotarse y consumirse, para testimoniar su amor; y a cambio recibo de la mayor parte sólo ingratitud, por su irreverencia y sacrilegio, y por la frialdad y desprecio que Me tienen en este Sacramento de Amor (la Eucaristía)".

Durante las apariciones de Fátima y después, el Señor estableció la devoción al Inmaculado Corazón de Su Madre. Jesús le dijo a Lucía:

"Ten compasión del Corazón de tu Santísima Madre, cubierto de espinas, con las que los hombres ingratos lo traspasan a cada momento, y no hay quien haga acto de reparación para quitárselas".



In the 1600s, Jesus revealed to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque the devotion to His Sacred Heart in order to increase our love:

"Behold the Heart which has so loved men that It has spared nothing, even to exhausting and consuming Itself, in order to testify Its love; and in return, I receive from the greater part only ingratitude, by their irreverence and sacrilege, and by the coldness and contempt they have for Me in this Sacrament of Love (the Eucharist)."

During the apparitions of Fatima and after, the Lord established devotion to His mother's Immaculate Heart. Jesus said to Lucia:

"Have compassion on the Heart of your most holy Mother, covered with thorns, with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment, and there is no one to make an act of reparation to remove them."

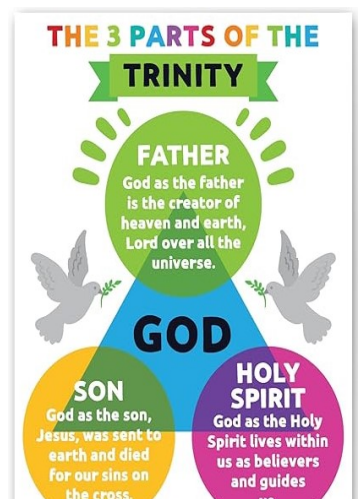

ALIMENTO CELESTIAL

God sustained the people of Israel for forty years in the desert with manna from heaven, and Moses doesn't want them to forget it. God made water gush forth from the rock for them to drink, and Moses doesn't want them to forget this either. And Moses tells them—twice—that the food God sent was food that neither they nor their ancestors had ever tasted before.

Jesus also speaks of the bread that came from heaven, food that the Jewish people had never tasted before. Recalling the bread of the desert, Jesus doesn't want them to forget it either, explaining to them that it is bread and drink for eternal life. And Paul reiterates to the Corinthians and to all of us that in the bread and in the cup we participate in the Body and Blood of
